

Sample Independent Contractor Agreement

****Warning****: This document is a general template and should not be used directly without consulting a lawyer. The independent contractor agreement should be tailored to suit the specific nature of each project and the needs of the contracting parties.

1. Parties

This agreement is made on [contract date] between:

2. Scope of Work

2.1 The Client agrees to engage and the Contractor agrees to provide the following services:

7. Equipment and Tools

The Contractor shall provide their own equipment and tools necessary for the performance of the work at their own expense, unless otherwise agreed.

8. Intellectual Property

8.1 All work products created by the Contractor during the performance of this agreement shall be the property of the Client.

8.2 The Contractor agrees to transfer all intellectual property rights arising from the work to the Client.

9. Confidentiality

9.1 The Contractor agrees to keep confidential all information received from the Client during the performance of the work.

9.2 This confidentiality obligation shall survive the termination of this agreement.

10. Non-Competition and Non-Solicitation

10.1 During this agreement and for [specify period] after its termination, the Contractor agrees not to:

- Engage in business competing with the Client
- Solicit the Client's customers or employees

11. Termination

11.1 The Client may terminate this agreement by giving the Contractor at least [number of days] days' written notice.

11.2 In case of material breach by either party, the other party has the right to terminate the agreement immediately.

12. Liability

The Contractor shall be liable to the Client for damages arising from the Contractor's negligence or willful misconduct in performing the work, but such liability shall be limited to [specify amount] Baht.

13. Insurance

The Contractor shall maintain all legally required insurance and any necessary insurance for the performance of the work.

14. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from or in connection with this agreement shall be settled through negotiation. If an agreement cannot be reached, the case shall be brought before the court of competent jurisdiction.

15. Governing Law

This agreement is governed by and interpreted in accordance with Thai law.

16. Amendments

Any amendments to this agreement shall be effective only if made in writing and signed by both parties.
